Fees: Field trips to Dahlem are **\$5.00** per student with a \$50 minimum charge. Fees are payable on the day of the field trip. Cancellations made less than 48 hours in advance of the scheduled program are subject to a \$50 charge. Maximum 60 students per time slot. Each class will receive one \$10 coupon to use toward the program fee.

One adult (chaperone) is admitted free for every 10 children. For pre-school programs, one adult (chaperone) is admitted free for every 5 children. Carpool drivers admitted free.
