<u>Dahlem's Five Year Infrastructure Improvement Projects Update:</u>

2016-2021

The replacement of the Beck Bridge was the latest infrastructure improvement project completed during the last five years. These projects were selected to ensure the safety of our visitors, students, and staff; and to enhance the learning experience of our students and visitors. The projects that have been completed since 2016 are:

- 1. Replaced the Boardwalk over the Nature for all Trail 2016
- 2. Completed the second addition to the Playscape 2017
- 3. Did a restoration of the Aquatics Study Pond to a useful state 2018
- 4. Replaced the Boardwalk over the Reflection Pond 2018
- 5. Renovated the North Building's restrooms and added a restroom in the Little

Acorns Nature Preschool classroom - 2019

- 6. Resurfaced and added spaces to the Community Gardens parking lot 2020
- 7. Replaced the old Beck Bridge 2021

Planned Projects for 2022

- 1. Replace the Boardwalk over the Vernal Pond. This project is planned for the fourth quarter. We are seeking donations and grants to fund this project. The cost for this project is \$63,000. Thank you to the Speckhard-Knight Foundation who has donated \$25,000 to the project.
- 2. Prescribed burn in the Prairie
- 3. Resurface the Nature for All Trail
